## **HISTORY OF OLD SPRING HILL PLANTATION**

Rich in history and steeped in tradition, Old Spring Hill Plantation stands today as a living example of Southern Hospitality at its finest. No longer a working cotton plantation, this large expanse of rolling hills, fields and pine forest has been converted into a sportsman's paradise complete with exceptional meals and gracious accommodations. The "main house," built in 1841 for the plantation master, is just a stone-throw away from the old mule barn and the original cotton gin. Scattered about in the pecan orchard are several of the original slave quarters. Campers will explore the beautiful 3,000 acres of land which includes 110 acres of lakes.
